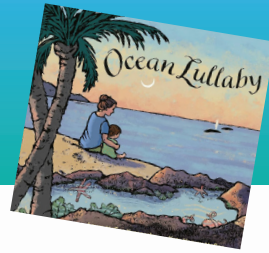

STATEWIDE BOOK ACCESS PARTNER \$50,000-\$100,000

- Host a Reading Rally with a children's book author
- Put thousands of books in the hands of children and families in an underserved community or Title I school
- Provide literacy and read aloud activities
- Launch an Imagination Library in a local community

COMMUNITY ACCESS PARTNER \$15,000

- Sponsor a Reading Rally at a Title I School
- Provide books for every student
- Give Read for 15 bookmarks to every child with your company's logo and a QR code with literacy activities

REGIONAL BOOK ACCESS PARTNER \$25,000
