ABOUT E3 ELEVATE EARLY EDUCATION .

E3: Elevate Early Education is a nonpartisan issue-advocacy organization that advocates for policy initiatives and state funds to be invested in early learning through third grade. Our work focuses on improving equitable access to quality education for all children.

In 2005, we started tackling this issue on the regional level as one of the first early education initiatives in the state. After a decade of innovative work, we recognized Virginia's investment in young children had flatlined and Virginia was behind other states. That led to the creation of E3 in 2011.

Together, WE have **increased access to quality** for thousands of children and families. WE **worked to improve the quality** in early learning programs and help teachers in the classroom.



Closing the Opportunity Gap: Early Learning to Third Grade

Our children, families, teachers, early learning programs and schools are struggling. Education from early learning on up must be our **#1 priority**.

Learning, readiness and reading gaps have widened during the pandemic. Too many of Virginia's children are behind and at high risk of reading and math failure. The research is clear. Investing in quality early learning up to third grade benefits **all children**, families, communities and society.

When our children fail, WE as taxpayers pay the price.

Of children are NOT READY for kindergarten in literacy, math, social skills and self-regulation.



Every child deserves the opportunity to learn, grow, and thrive. The reading and math gaps are widening.



More Black, Hispanic, economically-disadvantaged + English learners are at a higher risk of not being ready for Kindergarten.



EARLY LITERACY MATTERS



1 in 6 children fall below the literacy benchmark.



Third grade is a critical benchmark. Children through third grade are learning to read, then they are reading to learn.



The first eight years matter and build a foundation for learning.



The continuity of quality must build from year to year, academically and socially, for ALL children.



Third graders not reading on grade level are 4 times more likely to DROP OUT OF SCHOOL.

INNOVATION AT WORK @ THE NEW E3 SCHOOL


The New E3 School is a state-of-the-art, mixed-income model for children ages 1 to 5. Our school is a catalyst for policy change in the region and state. We have proven that when **all children** have access to quality, they enter kindergarten ready academically and socially.

The STREAMin3 model can be replicated and scaled in faith-based, Head Start, private programs and the state funded Virginia Preschool Initiative (VPI), for at-risk children.

Our Results:

- High quality is consistent and strong in every classroom (CLASS, 2022).
- Teachers are engaged in strong interactions.
- Most of our children met or exceeded kindergarten readiness benchmarks.
- More children are not meeting the literacy benchmark.









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OUR AWARENESS & ADVOCACY CAMPAIGNS



BIG WINS FOR OUR KIDS

Defined the readiness gap by creating the Virginia Kindergarten Readiness Program (VKRP) in partnership with the Virginia Department of Education (VDOE) and UVA to give teachers a tool to understand the learning gaps and drive policy and investment.

Advocated & secured \$85 Million in historical investments to improve equitable access to quality for children and families.

Worked with Democrats & Republicans to make early education a nonpartisan issue.

Advocated & secured \$10 Million in federal GEER funds to help early learning programs during the pandemic.

Piloted the preschool version of the VKRP in The New E3 School & advocated for the expansion of the tool.

Advocated and secured expansion of the VKRP+ Pilot for grades 1-3!

Met with gubernatorial candidates & policymakers to emphasize that education starting with early learning must be a top priority.

Advocated for the Virginia Literacy Act **to be fully funded!**

Advocated & advanced the expansion of The New E3 School & UVA's STREAMin3 curriculum model to be available to all early learning programs.
